## Purpose

To introduce CAL FIRE's new Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF) Forest Management Grant Programs and State Responsibility Area (SRA) Fire Prevention Grant Program to stakeholders. Discussions will include eligibility, project types, funds available, application process, timeline, allocation priorities, etc.

## Target Audience

Landowners, Registered Professional Foresters, fire prevention personnel, public agencies, Native American Tribes (only for some GGRF grants), universities, nonprofit organizations such as fire safe councils, and others who would like to obtain funding to implement a variety of forest management projects and/or fire prevention practices/activities that address the risk and potential impact of wildfire to habitable structures in SRA.

## Types of Grant Programs/Projects

### Greenhouse Gas Reduction Projects include:

- Fuels Reduction – Vegetation removal for wildfire hazard reduction.
- Reforestation – Planting forest trees.
- Forest Pest Control – Improve forest health by thinning forest and controlling pests.
- GHG Research – Research to study GHG reduction and carbon sequestration projects.
- PTEIRs -- Program Environmental Impact Reports for improved timber management
- Urban Forestry – A variety of projects that expand and improve urban forests.
- Forest Legacy Program – Conservation Easements

All GGRF projects must include a methodology and demonstrate and measure the potential for greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reductions and carbon sequestration benefits.

### SRA Fire Prevention Projects include:

- Vegetation clearance to reduce wildfire intensity and rate of spread.
- Selective tree removal (thinning) to improve forest health to withstand wildfire.
- Wildland pre-fire prevention projects, such as Community Wildfire Prevention Plans (CWPP's).
- Emergency evacuation planning.
- Fire prevention public education.
- Wildfire risk reduction planning documents.
- Community fire prevention programs such as community chipping days.

SRA Fire Prevention Grant Projects must be located within SRA, and address the risk and potential impact of wildfire to habitable structures throughout SRA.
